Isi abstract

Program Bank Sampah saat ini sedang berlangsung di kecamatan Ngamprah dan Kecamatan Lembang khususnya untuk masyarakat Desa Tani Mulya dan Desa Langensari. Masyarakat wilayah tersebut tidak memahami pentingnya pengelolaan dan tidak memiliki fasilitas dalam pengelolaan sampah. Oleh karena itu swadaya masyarakat di daerah tersebut mengadakan program Bank Sampah supaya masyarakat bisa memahami manfaat pentingnya dalam pengelolaan sampah, dan perlu partisipasi masyarakat agar program yang di adakan swadaya masyarakat berjalan secara berkelanjutan. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mengukur tingkat partisipasi masyarakat terhadap progam Bank Sampah teutama pada kriteria yaitu sikap, keuntungan, ketersediaan tempat sampah, kesedian memilah sampah terhadap program yang sedang berjalan. Data penelitian diperoleh dengan cara melakukan kuesioner dengan metode wawancara kepada nasabah Bank Sampah Sahdu dan Masyarakat cinta lingkungan. Hasil yang diperoleh dianalisis secara deskriptif kuantitatif. Pengukuran tingkat partisipasi masyarakat menggunakan konsep *Arnstein* dengan mengelompokkan partisipasi masyarakat pada 8 level. Hasil dari pengukuran partisipasi masyarakat di Bank Sampah Sahdu tertinggi pada level Partnership sebesar 42%. Presentase terendah yaitu Informing, Therapy dan Manipulation sebesar 0%, sedangkan di Bank Sampah Masyarakat Cinta Lngkungan tertinggi yaitu Citizen Control sebesar 35%, presentase terendah yaitu Informing, Therapy dan Manipulation sebesar 0% dan selanjutnya hasil yang di dapatkan digunakan oleh swadaya masyarakat sebagai referensi dan acuan untuk menjalankan program Bank Sampah.

Point abstract

The Garbage Bank program that is ongoing in Ngamprah and Lembang sub-districts, especially for the community of Tani Mulya and Langensari villages. The people of the area do not understand the importance of management and do not have facilities in waste management. Therefore, the non-governmental organizations in the area are organizing the Waste Bank program so that the community can understand its important benefits in waste management, and it requires the participation of the community so that the self-help programs run sustainably. The purpose of this study is to measure the level of community participation in the Waste Bank program especially in the criteria of namely attitudes, benefits, availability of trash bins, willingness to separate with an ongoing program. The research data were obtained by conducting a questionnaire with the interview method to the customers of the Sahdu Garbage Bank and the community love the environment. The results obtained were analyzed descriptively quantitatively. Measurement of the level of community participation uses Arnsstein's concept by grouping community participation at 8 levels. The results of the measurement of community participation in the Waste Bank Sahdu were highest at the informing level Partnership of 42%. The lowest percentage is informing, therapy, manipulation of 0%. While in the community love the environment highest is Citizen Control of 35%, the low presentage is infprmng, therapy and manipulation of 0% and furthermore, these results can be used by non-governmental organizations as a reference and reference for running the Waste Bank program.
